Gen. 2:1 heavens, earth and all the host -- finished
2 God rested on the 7th day
3 He blessed the 7th day -- and sanctified it
-- because He rested from all His work
which God had created and made

Exod. 16:22 6th day -- gather twice as much
23 6th day -- bake and boil
25 Sabbath -- you will not find it in the field
26 6 days you shall gather it -- not on Sabbath
28 the Lord said to Moses -- "How long do you
refuse to keep My commandments and My
laws?" -- notice, these commandments and
laws were given BEFORE Exodus 20
29 the Lord has given you the Sabbath
30 they rested on the 7th day

15 after that Sabbath -- count 7 Sabbaths
16 after the 7 Sabbath -- grain offering
24 Feast of Trumpets -- a Sabbath-rest
25 no customary work
32 Day of Atonement -- a Sabbath of solemn rest
-- you shall celebrate your Sabbath
38 besides the Sabbaths of the Lord -- give
gifts, vows and freewill offerings
39 Feast of Tabernacles -- 1st & 8th days -- a
Sabbath-rest

Lev. 25:1-7 a land Sabbath
Num. 15:32-36 gathered sticks on the Sabbath day -- stoned
Num. 28:9-10 burnt offering for every Sabbath -- besides
the regular burnt offering with its
drink offering

Neh. 10:31 no buying or selling -- wares or grain
Neh. 13:15-16 in those days, I saw transactions on Sabbath
17-18 I contended with the nobles of Judah
19 I commanded the gates shut on Sabbath
20 merchants and sellers -- lodged outside
21 I will lay hands on you -- they left
22 I commanded Levites to cleanse themselves and
to guard the gates -- to sanctify the
Sabbath
Isaiah 56:2 blessed -- keeps from defiling the Sabbath
6-7 everyone who keeps from defiling the Sabbath
-- I will bring to My holy mountain
Isaiah 58:13 if you turn away your foot from the Sabbath
* turn from doing you own pleasure on My holy day
* call My Sabbath a delight
* call the holy day of the Lord honorable
* honor Him, not doing your own ways
* honor Him, not finding your own pleasure
* honor Him, not speaking your own words
* (Moffatt twice called "pleasure" as "business")
Jer. 17:21-22 bear no burden on Sabbath day -- nor bring it
into the gates of Jerusalem -- carry no
burden out of your houses on Sabbath day
-- nor do any work
24-26 consequences for disobedience
27 consequences for obedience

* Son of God taught on Sabbath day
Mark 1:21 Jesus taught in the synagogue on the sabbath
Luke 4:16 Jesus went to the synagogue on the sabbath
day and stood up to read
31 Jesus taught on the sabbath day
* Defended His disciples eating on Sabbath
Matt. 12:1 disciples -- plucked heads of grain to eat
2 Pharisees complained
3-8 Son of God referred to David and showbread
7 quoted -- "I desire mercy and not sacrifice"
8 "The Son of Man is Lord even of the Sabbath"
Mark 2:23-28 Mark's version
Luke 6:1-5 Luke's version
* Son of God healed on Sabbath day
Matt. 12:9-10 man with withered hand -- they asked -- "Is
it lawful to heal on the Sabbath?" --
wanting to accuse Him
