	followers – more than the wrong behavior of the fake apostles)

#1 – Paul identified – people following other people into bondage

#2 – Paul identified – people allowing other people to devour them

#3 – Paul identified – people allowing other people to take away from them – (which I believe applies mainly to money or property)

King James for you suffer – if a man takes from you
New King James for you put up with it – if one takes from you
Revised Standard for you bear it – if a man takes advantage of you
Amplified New Testament for you endure it – if a man deceives you & takes

advantage of you

- "Allowing religious people to take money from you" versus "Teaching people to give" –
 4 concepts
 - 1. Do NOT follow religious people who are pre-occupied with money (Many people who allege to be a religious leader aren't from God) (Resisting someone does not have to be confrontational)
- Rom. 16:17 avoid people divisions and offenses wrong doctrine serve their own belly
