- A reminder from the Part 1 – trumpets – during bad times and good times

Num. 10:9	you shall sound an alarm with the trumpets – when you go to war in your land against the enemy who pressed you
10	you shall blow the trumpets – also, in the day of gladness – in your appointed feasts and at the beginning of your months

- Part 3 – New Testament scriptures – Calamity and Restoration

Rev. 1:10	John said: “I was in the Spirit of the Day of the Lord, and I heard behind me a loud voice as of a trumpet, saying ‘I am the Alpha and the Omega, the First and the Last’ and “What you see, write in a book and sent it to the seven churches which are in Asia.”
Rev. 4:1	John said: “I looked and behold, a door standing open in heaven. And the first voice which I heard was like a trumpet speaking with me saying, “Come up here, and I will show you things which must take place after this.”
Rev. 6:1-2	the Lamb opened one of the seals
3-4	He opened the 2nd seal
5-6	He opened the 3rd seal
7-8	He opened the 4th seal
9-11	He opened the 5th seal
12-17	He opened the 6th seal

Rev. 8:1	the Lamb opened the 7th seal
2	I saw the 7 angels who stand before God – to them were given 7 trumpets
6	so the 7 angels who had the 7 trumpets prepared themselves to sound
7	the 1st angel sounded
8-9	the 2nd angel sounded
10-11	the 3rd angel sounded
12	the 4th angel sounded
13	“Woe, woe, woe to the inhabitants of the earth, because of the remaining blasts of the trumpet of the 3 angels who are about to sound”
Rev. 9:1-12	the 5th angel sounded
13-21	the 6th angel sounded
14	saying to the 6th angel who had the trumpet – “Release the four angels who are bound at the great river Euphrates”
Rev. 11:15	the 7th angel sounded – “the kingdoms of this world have become the kingdoms of our Lord and of His Christ, and He shall reign forever and ever!”
16-18	the 24 elders (who sat before God on their thrones) fell on their faces and worshiped God
Matt. 24:29	immediately after the tribulation of those days, the sun will be darkened and the moon will not give its light – the stars will fall from heaven – and the power of the heavens will be shaken
30	then the sign of the Son of Man will appear in heaven, and then all tribes of the earth will mourn – and they will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory
31	and He will send His angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they will gather together His elect from the four winds – from one end of heaven to the other
1 Cor. 15:50	I tell you brethren – flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God, nor does corruption inherit incorruption
51	behold, I tell you a mystery – we shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed – in a moment – in the twinkling of an eye – at the last trumpet – for the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised – incorruptible – and we shall be changed
1 Thes. 4:16	for the Lord Himself will descend from heaven – with a shout, with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet of God – the dead in Christ will rise first
17	then, we who are alive and remain – shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air – and thus, we shall always be with the Lord
18	therefore, comfort one another with these words
1 Thes. 5:1-3	the Day of the Lord comes as a thief in the night
4-5	sons of light
6-10	not sleep
11	comfort one another
12-28	various – words of encouragement
