1. To Be Blessed Now

Obeying God is wise – Disobeying God is stupid

Deut. 5:29	"that it might be well with them and with their children forever"
Deut. 6:24	"for our good always, that He might preserve us alive"
Deut. 30:19	choose life – "that both you and your descendants may live"
Psalm 111:10	the fear (respect) of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom
Prov. 9:10	the fear (respect) of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom – the knowledge
	of the Holy One is understanding
Ezek. 33:11	why will you die, Oh house of Israel?
Luke 4:40	many sick people followed Christ – to be healed
John 6:26	the Son of God said – "you seek Me not because you saw the signs, but
	because you ate of the loaves and were filled"
Mark 10:29-30	the Son of God said – if people have left house, brother, sister, father or mother, wife or children, or lands "for My sake and the gospel's [sake] – they shall receive 100 fold now – houses, brothers, sisters, mothers, children, lands (and persecutions) – and in the age to come, eternal life
Psalm 119:1-2	blessed are those who walk in the law of the Lord – those who keep His testimonies – those who seek Him with their whole heart
99	"I have more understanding than all my teachers, for your testimonies are my meditation"
105	"Your word is a lamp to my feet, and a light to my path"

2. To Be Blessed at the Resurrection

Notice what the Son of God said

Matt. 19:28	you who have followed Me will sit on 12 thrones
29	inherit eternal life
Matt. 25:14-30	parable of the talents
Luke 19:12-27	parable of the pounds

Rev. 2:7 11 17 26-28 Rev. 3:5 12 21 Rev. 20:4 6 Rev. 22:12	overcome – tree of life, which is in the midst of the Paradise of God overcome – not be hurt by the second death overcome – hidden manna – white stone – new name overcome – power over the nations overcome – white raiment – book of life – new name overcome – pillar in the temple of My God – new name overcome – to sit with Christ on His throne vision to John – thrones, reigning with Christ for 1,000 years vision to John – first resurrection – blessed and holy – no second death – priests of God and Christ "My reward is with Me to give to every one according to his work"
