## Obey God to be Blessed Now – Part 1 (Part 1 – Tonight, we will spend our time in the Pentateuch) God saw everything that He had made, and indeed it was very good Gen. 1:31 God rested on the 7<sup>th</sup> day – blessed the 7<sup>th</sup> day and sanctified it Gen. 2:1-3 the Lord God formed a man from the dust of the ground 7 15 the Lord God put the man in the garden – to tend and keep it the Lord God commanded the man – "you may freely eat of every tree in 16-17 the garden, except from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil - in the day that you eat of it, you shall die" the Lord God made Eve - from Adam's rib 21-24 Gen. 3:1-3 the serpent questioned Eve the serpent mislead Eve 4-5 6 Eve and Adam – disobeyed 7 they knew they were naked they hid from the Lord God 8-12 she realized that the serpent deceived her 13 14-15 consequences for the serpent 16 consequences for women consequences for men 17-19 the Lord God said – "because they have become like one of Us (to know 22-23 good and evil), We need to send them out of the garden of Eden – before they eat of the tree of life and life forever" 24 He drove them out – He placed cherubim and a flaming sword (which turned every way) to guard the way to the tree of life
