 - Comment – Those 3 reasons were:
 1. To be Blessed Now
 2. To be Blessed at the Resurrection
 3. To Glorify and to Honor the Father and Son
 - Comment – I gave 2 presentations on the first concept – “To Be Blessed Now”

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- Foundational scripture

Luke 14:14 to be blessed at the resurrection

- A few scriptures in the Old Testament – (5 references)

Exod. 3:6	the Lord said: “I am the God of your father – the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac and the God of Jacob”
Matt. 22:23-28	the Sadducees (didn’t believe in a resurrection) – asked a question
29	you don’t know the scriptures, not the power of God
31	“concerning the resurrection of the dead, have you not read what God said?” – “I am the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac and the God of Jacob” – “God is not the God of the dead, but of the living”
Job 19:25-27	Job made comments about a resurrection
Isaiah 26:19	“Your dead shall live; together with my dead body, they shall arise. Awake and sing, you who dwell in dust – for your dew is like the dew of herbs, and the earth shall cast out the dead”
Dan. 12:1	“At that time, Michael shall stand up (the great prince who stands watch over the sons of your people) and there shall be a time of trouble such as never was since there was a nation – even to that time. And at that time, your people shall be delivered, every one who is found written in the book”
2	“And many of those who sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake – some to everlasting life, some to shame and everlasting contempt”

- “Resurrection” – mentioning Christ’s resurrection – (15 references)

- “Raised” – mentioning Christ being raised – (19 references)

Matt. 16:21	Acts 3:15, 26	Acts 17:31	Eph. 1:20-23

John 2:19-22	Acts 5:30	Rom. 6:4, 9	2 Tim. 2:8

- “Resurrection” – referring to a future resurrection of saints – (2 references)

Acts 24:21	2 Tim. 2:18
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- “Raised” – referring to a future raising of saints – (4 references)

John 6:39-40	John 6:44, 54	Acts 26:8	2 Cor. 1:9
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- “Raised” – mentioning both Christ & saints being raised – (5 references)

Rom. 8:11	the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus – will raise you
Rom. 10:9	believe that God raised Christ = you will be saved
1 Cor. 6:14	God raised up the Lord and He will also raise us up
2 Cor. 4:14	He who raised up the Lord will also raise us up
Eph. 2:5-6	made alive together with Christ – raised up together – sit together

- “Raised” and “Resurrected” mentioned together – (1 Corinthians 15)

1 Cor. 15:12-13	how can people say that there is no resurrection
15-17	He raised up Christ – if He is not risen, preaching is empty
21	by man also came the resurrection of the dead
35-58	wonderful description of the resurrection

- “Resurrection” – Blessed at the future Resurrection – (5 sections)

John 5:29	resurrection of life – resurrection of condemnation
Acts 24:15	Paul believed in resurrection of the dead – just and unjust
Phil. 3:10-11	past resurrection – future resurrection
Heb. 11:35	some – that they might attain a better resurrection
Rev. 20:5-6	the first resurrection
