Jeremiah 9:23 good habits to develop – but not to glory in these habits

- · wisdom
- · might (physical strength)
- · financial wisdom
- glory in this that you understand and know the Lord "I am the Lord exercising loving-kindness, judgment and righteousness in the earth; for I delight in these"

John 5

John 5:1	Christ went to Jerusalem
2	Sheep Gate a pool – with five porches
3	great multitude – sick people, blind, lame, paralyzed – waiting for the moving of the water
4	an angel stirred the water – whoever stepped into the water (after the water moved) was made well of whatever disease he had
5	a certain man – an infirmity for 38 years
6	Christ asked – "do you want to be made well?"
7	he answered – "people keep stepping in front of me"
8-9	Christ said – "rise, take up your bed and walk" – immediately made well
10	people – "it is the Sabbath; it is not lawful for you to carry you bed"
11	Christ said – "take up your bed and walk"
12-15	the people found out that Christ was the person
16-18	the people wanted to kill Him
19-47	wonderful words

John 6

John 6:1-2	a great multitude followed Christ, when they saw Him heal diseases
3	Christ went up the mountain and sat with His disciples
4	(Passover was near)
5	He said to Philip – "where shall we buy bread, that these may eat?"
6	Christ was testing Philip – because He knew what He would do
7-9	Philip and Andrew – gave suggestions
10-14	Christ fed them
15	when Christ perceived that the people were about to get Him, He went by
	Himself to the mountain
16-21	some activity involving a boat
22-25	next day – more activity involving a boat
26	Christ – acknowledged that part of the reason people followed Him – was for the food
26-65	wonderful words
