The word “psephos” (Strong’s #5586) – stone, vote (cast by stones) – “In New Testament times, a white stone usually meant a vote for innocence, a black stone a vote for guilt; the white stone of Rev. 2:17 may picture the innocence of its owner.”

Acts 26:10	“This I also did in Jerusalem, and many of the saints I shut up in prison, having received authority from the chief priests; and when they were put to death, I cast my vote against [#5586] them.”		
Rev. 2:18-28 26-28	to the angel of the Church in Thyatira to him who overcomes · I will give power over the nations – He shall rule them with a rod of iron; they shall be dashed to pieces like the potter’s vessels · I will give him the morning star		
1 Cor. 15:24-28 Rev. 22:16	The Father – the Son – resurrected brethren Jesus is the Bright and Morning Star		
Rev. 3:1-6 5	to the angel of the Church in Sardis to him who overcomes · He shall be clothed in white garments · I will not blot out his name from the Book of Life · I will confess his name before My Father & His angels		
Rev. 16:15 Matt. 10:32 Exod. 32:32-33	blessed is he who watches and keeps his garments Son of God – confess Me before men, I will confess before My Father Book of Life

Rev. 3:14-22 21	to the angel of the Church of the Laodiceans to him who overcomes · I will grant to sit with Me on My throne – as I have overcome & sat down with My Father on His throne
