1. Children of God were filled with the Holy Spirit

Acts 2:1-4 they were filled with the Holy Spirit
Acts 10:44-48 the gift of the Holy Spirit had been poured out on the Gentiles also

- Reminder of a “better covenant”

Heb. 8:6 more excellent ministry – Mediator of a better covenant – better promises
7 if the first covenant had been faultless, there would have been no need for
 a second
8 finding fault with them
13 He has made the first obsolete – what is becoming obsolete and growing
 old is ready to vanish away

- Reminder of a “spiritual temple”

Acts 7:47-48 Notice what Luke wrote in the book of Acts
 Solomon built a house for God – but the Most High does not dwell
 in temples made with hands

Eph. 2:19-22 notice what Paul wrote
19 household of God
20 foundation of the apostles and prophets
 · Jesus Christ Himself = chief cornerstone
21 the body grows into a holy temple in the Lord
22 dwelling place of God, in the Spirit

1 Peter 2:4-5 notice what Peter wrote
4 coming as living stones
5 spiritual house – holy priesthood – spiritual sacrifices

2. Children of God received the 10 Commandments

Exod. 20:2	because the Lord brought you out of the land of Egypt
3-17	the 10 Commandments
Matt. 19:20-21	even more than the 10 commandments – we all have some personal weaknesses
Matt. 22:36-40	the great commandment
Matt. 23:23	weightier matters of the law – justice, mercy & faith
Mark 7:3	traditions of the elders
7	teaching as doctrines the commandments of men
8	traditions – (I like to call rituals)
9	people reject the commandment of God that you may keep your tradition (rituals)
10-13	He specifically mentioned the Fifth Commandment
