A press release via Lionsgate has announced the theatrical re-release of Mel Gibson’s “The Passion of the Christ” in a 4K-remastered version with Dolby Atmos sound, from September 10 through September 17.

If you purchase tickets for the re-release, you’ll get a sneak peek at “The Resurrection of the Christ: Part One,” which the studio describes as Gibson’s “most ambitious filmmaking achievement” and the “largest faith film ever brought to the screen.”

I don’t know if I want to re-live the torture porn of the original ‘Christ’ on the big screen again, and I vividly remember the experience of watching it, in a packed house, back in 2004. An experience I’ll never forget.

Gibson isn’t scared of showing violence in the movies he directs, and the Bible isn’t tame on the gore either, with the film making us very aware of that, recounting Jesus’ final days of suffering before his ultimate crucifixion. There are only three sentences in the Bible that mention the flogging of Jesus, and yet Gibson dedicates more than 10 minutes of screentime to Jesus getting whipped, skin shredded, until he collapses.

The crucifixion scene isn't any better, as Gibson clearly wants the audience to feel Jesus' pain and suffering as much as possible. Yet Gibson has been on record stating that he believes that the Bible describes a far more horrific crucifixion than the movie. The film is shocking, extreme, and tries to make you feel the "enormity of the sacrifice."

Now, I'm not sure if "The Resurrection of the Christ," divided into two parts, will be as graphic, but it does tackle Jesus' descent into hell, his battle with angels and demons, and Gibson has described the film as an "acid trip." When it comes to Gibson, expect the unexpected.

Jim Caviezel and Monica Bellucci will not be returning in 'Resurrection.' In their place, relatively lesser-known talents take the reins: Finnish actor Jaakko Ohtonen plays Jesus, Cuban actress Mariela Garriga is Mary, Polish-born Kasia Smutniak portrays Mary, Italy's Pier Luigi Pasino is Peter, and Riccardo Scamarcio takes on Pontius Pilate. Rupert Everett remains a mysterious addition.

Lionsgate has dated "The Resurrection of the Christ" as a two-part release. Part One is set to open on May 6, 2027, and "Part Two" scheduled for May 25, 2028. Nothing says summer movie season quite like Jesus' descent into hell.

There's never been another country like America. That's not mere patriotic hyperbole for our 250th anniversary. It's historical fact. But many of us have never really understood it. Or maybe we forgot what we heard in school on the subject a long time ago. Or did we ever hear it? Today most schools wouldn't dare say anything along such lines, which is precisely why I wrote my book "REVOLUTION: The Birth of the Greatest Nation in the History of the World."

But it's something most Americans used to know —and it's extremely important. We need to start with the American Revolution itself, which is the only revolution in world history that actually delivered on the promises it made, to create a country where the people were in charge, a country that — in Lincoln's famous words — was "conceived in liberty and dedicated to the proposition that all men are created equal."

Of course other revolutions claimed to be about the same thing, promising that when everything was all over "the people" would be in charge. But every one betrayed this, creating levels of misery and suffering that are almost unimaginable.

Take the French Revolution, which began just a few years after our own Revolution, and was championed by some of the figures involved in our Revolution — like Thomas Jefferson and Thomas Paine. They all seemed to think it would be a happy reprisal of what happened here. It was anything but that, ending in a nightmare bloodbath of terror.

What went wrong? Just like us, the French decided they didn't like the idea of monarchy. So they beheaded their king and queen. But the radicals didn't stop there.

They also decided to kill every priest and nun. Let's just say it didn't go well for anyone.

Where the American revolutionaries were mostly people of faith — and saw their faith as the very reason they were doing what they were doing — the French revolutionaries saw faith and the church as the problem. The Americans declared that their liberties came from God, and that it was the role of government to protect those liberties. The French didn't know where their liberties came from. So they traded King Louis XVI for a dictator named Napoleon—who crowned himself emperor.

Whatever happened to the noble French ideals of liberte, egalite, and fraternite?

Then there are the even worse nightmares of the Bolshevik and Maoist revolutions in Russia and China. The Soviets murdered the Tsar and his family, giving the Russian people the sadistic leadership of Lenin and Stalin and the hell of what Solzhenitsyn called “the Gulag Archipelago.” The Chinese communists got rid of the Emperor and — just like the Soviets — murdered millions of their own people.

Every one of these “revolutions” was a false revolution that actually replaced suffering with more suffering, and inequality with more inequality, creating dystopian worlds too awful to contemplate.

- So how did these so-called revolutions get it so grotesquely wrong?
- And how did we in the American Revolution get it right, creating a nation where the people really did govern themselves, just as was hoped and promised, and are continuing to do so, 250 years later?

The answer couldn't be simpler. The leaders of our Revolution understood that it wasn't enough to get rid of a king or a tsar or emperor and hope for the best. You couldn't just tear down what you didn't like. You had to replace it with something else. But what?

The answer is so simple many people refuse to believe it. You can say it in three letters: “God.”

I'll bet you didn't hear that in your public school social studies class. But it's undeniable. Of course the men of the American Revolution knew they couldn't force God on anyone, because

they believed in liberty, especially religious liberty. So if faith was necessary, it would need to come from the people themselves, voluntarily. The whole thing was a gamble, or as many have said, “an experiment.”

But the reason they thought it might work in 1776 was because it had been working for the previous 150 years. Most of the Americans in the Revolution were descended from men and women who in the previous century had braved dangerous sea-crossings to live out their Christian faith as they saw fit. And during all this time they really had been self-governing. So faith in the God of the Bible was almost ubiquitous in Colonial America, and actually increased during the Great Awakening, under the preaching of the evangelist George Whitefield, who was the biggest celebrity of his time.

Three-quarters of everyone in the colonies heard him preach in person at least once. So the Americans were a decidedly faith-filled people.

When the British in the 1760s decided to crack down on the Colonies, and tax them and persecute them, they pushed back. Hard. They had the crazy idea that they were still free men and women who could govern themselves and tax themselves. After all, hadn't they been doing so for over a century? And they knew that their liberties were God-given, not given to them by parliament or the king.

So when in 1776 they finally decided to declare independence from the monarch in Great Britain, they were simultaneously reaffirming their dependence on God. And they weren't shy about saying so.

On August 1st, the day before the members of Congress officially signed the Declaration of Independence, they gathered to hear Samuel Adams give a speech on the steps of Independence Hall. In it he declared “We have this day restored the Sovereign, to whom all men ought to be obedient.” Adams — whom they called the “Father of the Revolution” — was saying it explicitly.

Here was a member of Congress telling every other member of Congress that God was the ruler of the brand new nation, and that if we looked to him for guidance, we could govern ourselves. We would do something that hadn't been done in three thousand years. Just like the ancient Israelites in the Sinai wilderness, who escaped bondage under Pharaoh, we would look to God directly, and would rule ourselves without an earthly king. Everyone in Congress understood this.

When asked to create a seal for the new nation, Benjamin Franklin and Thomas Jefferson — often thought the least religious of the founders — both came up with images of this very event. Franklin's image was of Moses watching God part the Red Sea while Pharaoh drowned and Jefferson's was of the Israelites being led by a pillar of fire and a cloud. Could anything be more clear? So why haven't most of us heard this before? Well, that's another story.

Win some blue-state and blue-city races, and the cocky new socialist Jacobins believe that they have either already taken over the Democratic Party or will soon absorb it. And in reaction to these new swarms, an increasingly terrified and ossified old Democrat guard either limps away from the hive or invites them in to take over more.

It is fascinating but ultimately depressing to watch old-style Democrats say or do anything to avoid the new mob of Robespierres. Democrat candidates who recently begged for a Schumer/Pelosi/Jeffries endorsement now are telling them to get in line at the guillotine.

Jewish American Democrats are terrified that what happened to the primaried and defeated Rep. Dan Goldman of New York, an arch-Trump hater, could befall them. Goldman’s obnoxious showboating hatred of Trump and championing of neo-socialist agendas offered no defense against the Jacobins’ antisemitism and hatred of Israel.

A number of Jewish Democrat candidates, like wannabe California congressman Scott Wiener, are backing off from Israel and now join the “genocide!” mob. Wiener hopes that the throng will reward his new anti-Israel position by overlooking the now inconvenient fact that to the anti-Semitic Democrat base he is still Jewish.

Some of the rich, likewise, think they can escape the guillotine—the various proposed taxes on “billionaires” and “millionaires” on their net worth or unrealized capital gains or plans to confiscate private properties deemed “not in the people’s interests.” They will either flee to Florida or join the mob and hope their donations spare them from the blade.

The hard socialist agenda, which lacks even 50 percent popular support, is often recognizable despite efforts to conceal it until after elections. Given the clickbait lunacy of these socialists’ mindset, their true views often trickle out from prior social media posts, hot mics, leaks, and occasional temper-tantrum outbursts (cf. Mamdani’s “monsters” or Talarico’s “I hate Christianity” or Platner’s litany of unapologetic racist, antisemitic, and misogynistic outbursts).

In general, the socialist challenge is to “fundamentally transform America” into a statist, inert redistribution machine—nuttier than socialist Europe, a prescription for North Korean-style poverty, and completely unrecognizable to the Founders and most contemporary Americans.

As far as we can distill, here are their agendas.

1. The New Demography: Open borders, massive, unaudited new immigration ending the distinction between mere residence and citizenship.
2. Dismantling the “System”: Packing the court, destroying the Electoral College, ending the filibuster, bringing in new left-wing states, defunding the police, ensuring same-day registration/voting, no voter ID, foreign nationals residing here being eligible to vote.
3. The Islamization of America: Ending America’s traditional friendship with Israel and realigning the U.S. with the West Bank, Hamas, Hezbollah, and their autocratic and illiberal, terrorism-sponsoring Muslim regimes. Restoring massive USAID subsidies to fund left-wing takeovers abroad and mainstreaming now overt harassment of Jews at home.
4. Old Communism: The government takeover of housing and utilities, targeted expropriation of private property, new punitive taxes on net worth and unrealized capital gains. Wild talk of nationalizing airlines and all health care.
5. Statism: Massive new entitlements, free college, canceling \$1.7 trillion in student loans, more federal acquisition of private lands, rent freezes.
6. Reparations: Compensation for victims of alleged “white privilege,” institutionalization of radical identity politics, and racial, ethnic, and sexual orientation chauvinism. Third world hatred of supposed white oppressors, justifying reparatory preferences for the non-white “oppressed.”
7. Globalism: Pledging solidarity with socialist/communist movements abroad while despising Western civilization in general and the U.S. in particular.

Once “Mayor” Zohran Mamdani took control of New York, he began promising to confiscate rental properties from landlords and to focus on “white” neighborhoods, and he no longer disguised his innate hatred of Jews.

Governor Spanberger of Virginia dropped her moderate false face and began radically ramming through hard-left executive orders to ensure more DEI, higher taxes, and anti-ICE hysterics. After being elected, Seattle Mayor Katie Willson gushed “bye-bye” to the billionaire entrepreneurs who are fleeing from Washington state’s new “millionaire’s tax.” She mocked their departure and cared not a whit that her now-socialist city would further descend into a West Coast Detroit or Baltimore.

Socialists hide their revolutionary anger with banal pleasantries. We have become well accustomed now to the “socialist smile,” emblemized by the grinning Mamdani or the faux-happy face of James Talarico.

Usually, the new touchy-feely socialists chuckle loudest when a rare reporter presses them on their past lunatic harangues, which are then laughed off as hysterias from paranoid right-wing minds.

Sometimes socialists embrace the hard commissar style, like the perpetually venomous Maine Senate candidate Graham Platner, who ridicules journalists, lies flagrantly, and takes back none of his hate-filled rants.

Rep. Rashida Tlaib (D-MI) perpetually screams rather than talks, usually venting her monotonous hatred for the Jewish state. Her latest socialist champions are the Antifa criminals just sentenced to long prison sentences for their conspiracy to murder ICE officers.

The more Ilhan Omar is caught trafficking in antisemitic tropes, denying alleged immigration fraud schemes, or filing preposterous federal financial disclosure forms, the more defiant her shouts of “racist” become.

The newly emerging socialists, like recent congressional nominees Darializa Avila Chevalier or Analilia Mejia, can never explain why their parents left socialist paradises in Latin America to come to cutthroat capitalist America.

Nor do they explain to us why and how such a supposedly toxic, racist nation would extend such generous scholarships and DEI preferences to both.

They suffer from the Joy Reid/Ilhan Omar/Rashida Tlaib/AOC socialist syndrome: parents flee socialist paradises of indigenous peoples to ensure their children might thrive in a settler/colonialist and capitalist U.S. whose magnanimity they interpret as proof of guilt that is therefore to be reciprocated not with gratitude but with ever more venom.

And once the second-generation socialists joined the privileged elite classes of America, these boutique radicals decided to tear down the very system that nurtured them, without ever expressing a wish to return to the socialist paradises of their parents’ homelands.

What drives the sheer hatred of the new upscale socialists, and why are they in vogue now?

There are three constants in all these new socialists, as we have seen recently from the recent nationwide primary elections, as well as the daily street theater.

- One, they hate the United States—loathe its foundation, hate its maturation, and despise the current American nation.

They detest especially the middle classes, who lack both the romance of the dependent poor and the supposed “refinement” and “culture” of their own elite socialist aristocracy. And the more they demagogue “white privilege” and “white supremacy,” the more they feel that the river of

exemptions, set-asides, preferences, and special considerations will flow to them from a supposedly guilty nation.

The socialists' hatred of America is becoming clearer as middle America embraces the 250th anniversary of the nation, highlighted by throngs of World Cup tourists who cannot praise highly enough the decency, amicability, and prosperity of America between the coasts. So, what is a perennial socialist PhD candidate, or a failed "community organizer," or NGO flack to do when millions happily suffer from "false consciousness" and have failed to listen to their Marxist handlers?

The socialist architects of the current Jacobin takeover see no contradiction in that, like moths harkening to flames, they cannot get enough of the American good life, conspicuous consumer consumption, and merit badges of success like their Ivy League-branded kids, letters and titles after their names, and the right zip code for their first and second homes.

Every socialist buffoon reminds us almost daily of Alexis de Tocqueville's droll warning that most people would prefer everyone to be absolutely equal and worse off than all better off, but with some better off than themselves.

The socialists' hatred of America is also revealed in their envy. Unlike the poet Hesiod's notion of a "good" envy—embodied in the American tradition of emulation and admiration of those richer than themselves—they buy into the "bad" envy of wanting to destroy those who are brighter, more successful, richer, and more essential to America than themselves, whether an Elon Musk, a Larry Ellison, or a Jeff Bezos.

- Second, socialists still have little current power other than their control of institutions such as K–12 education, academia, the media, foundations, the bureaucracies, the corporate boardrooms, professional sports, entertainment, and popular culture.

Perhaps they wish to end up like the lifelong government employee, Bernie Sanders, who for a half-century shook his two upraised fists at America, screamed at the greed, and ended up with three homes and membership in the millionaire class.

Socialists and communists have no confidence in winning over the majority of the American people, at least outside blue-city and blue-state districts. Hence, their efforts to change balloting laws, destroy the border, import angry, poor, new constituents, stage violent street confrontations, and either celebrate or contextualize assassinations from the attempts on Trump to the killing of Charlie Kirk.

Sane Democrats would reexamine 2024 and conclude the party was far too left-wing and the antidote was a return to the winning formulas of Bill Clinton. But unhinged socialists and communists would claim that 2024 was lost because they were not far-left enough. So we are to believe that Americans scared of Harris's poorly disguised radicalism can be won over by scaring

them even further? A communist in 2028 can win over America when a socialist in 2024 could not?

- Third, Donald Trump has driven the Left so crazy that they have gyrated from Obama's four-mansion socialism to unapologetic hardcore Trotskyism.

Why? Their pathological hatred transcends Trump's background, his appearance, his accent, his tweets, and even his appeal to the despised "clingers, irredeemables, deplorables, chumps, dregs, and garbage."

Of course, Trump is a conservative, so he suffers the same left-wing slurs of "fascist" and "Nazi" that met Ronald Reagan and George W. Bush. But in his second term, Trump, quite unlike most Republican presidents, is not addressing just symptoms but also the causes and fuel of the socialist project.

Trump did not just jawbone the "fake news" but cut off subsidies to NPR and PBS, suing the media when they deliberately engaged in baseless character assassination. He did not just close the border but began deporting the criminal cohort of Biden's 10 million illegal entrants, sought to end birthright citizenship, made would-be refugees apply for entry in their home country, ended catch-and-release, and will wall off or electronically secure the entire southern border from the Pacific to the Gulf of America.

He did not just rhetorically critique DEI; he banned it from the federal bureaucracy. Unlike past Republicans, Trump did not merely critique elitist campuses; he leveraged them to behave like normal people—taxing endowments, banning racist DEI protocols, prohibiting grant surcharge scamming, and demanding they abide by the Bill of Rights. He slashed the left-wing USAID money machine rather than just whining that it subsidized America's worst critics abroad.

In other words, the socialists are enraged not just because they despise the U.S. and lack the power to turn America into Cuba or because they have not yet stabbed, poisoned, shot, decapitated, or blown up the hated Trump, as their followers, celebrities, and a few of their leaders have so often boasted.

The real rub is that Trump is their flip side—not a revolutionary but a counterrevolutionary. He seeks to overturn root and branch the entire 100-year progressive project and ensure America's insidious slouching toward socialism ends with his term—for good. The more they brag about our collective socialist tomorrow, the more Trump incessantly dismantles socialism today.

So far, they haven't stopped him yet—but their lidless eyes never close.

The Democratic Socialists of America (DSA) evolved from being a relatively small group of activists into a growing force within the Democratic Party over four decades.

DSA is on pace to field its largest congressional delegation in its history after several members won their primaries against establishment Democrats. The movement has entered the mainstream Democratic Party ecosystem and continues gaining political influence after recent primary wins in New York and Colorado.

The DSA was founded in 1982 following a merger of the Democratic Socialist Organizing Committee and the New American Movement, according to DSA’s website. It initially focused on pushing the Democratic Party leftward on welfare state expansion, union rights and social justice.

The movement consisted of about 6,000 members and intended to build a coalition of feminists, racial minorities, trade unionists and socialists to fight back against social conservatives and a so-called “pro-war” labor movement.

The movement focused more on activism than on winning major political offices. In the 80s’, DSA activists prioritized social justice abroad and at home, participating in anti-apartheid and anti-intervention marches in Washington, D.C., and San Francisco in 1987.

In the 1990s, DSA built a “single-payer” movement, also known as “Medicare for All,” as an alternative to then-President Bill Clinton’s plan to make private insurance more affordable, according to its website. Members of the movement went from advocating for “Medicare for All” to having congressional members co-sponsoring legislation that would enact it into law.

After 9/11, DSA expanded its activism to being anti-war by protesting the Iraq and Afghanistan wars during former President George W. Bush’s presidency.

DSA reached a turning point when independent Vermont Sen. Bernie Sanders ran for president in 2016, though he was not a member of the DSA. During his candidacy, the movement surged from 6,000 to about 80,000 members, particularly as young people joined. DSA shifted its focus to addressing student debt, housing, raising wages and enacting socialized healthcare, all of which were widely supported by young liberals.

Sanders' presidential bid opened the door for democratic socialist candidates to enter mainstream Democratic politics and serve in Congress. DSA's electoral strategy became more aggressive by endorsing candidates like Democratic New York Rep. Alexandria Ocasio-Cortez, who became another central figure in incorporating DSA ideology into the Democratic Party after winning her congressional race in 2018.

Sanders also mainstreamed Medicare for All throughout his 2016 and 2020 candidacies.

Ocasio-Cortez and Democratic Massachusetts Sen. Ed Markey introduced the Green New Deal, a multi-trillion dollar proposal aimed at helping the U.S. achieve net-zero emissions within a decade.

The New York congresswoman co-sponsored Medicare for All, pushed for higher minimum wages and other far-left initiatives. Democratic Michigan Rep. Rashida Tlaib, who entered Congress at the same time as Ocasio-Cortez, also identifies as a democratic socialist.

DSA achieved more electoral victories in recent elections, most notably Democratic New York City Mayor Zohran Mamdani, who defeated former Democratic New York Gov. Andrew Cuomo in the November 2025 mayoral election. Mamdani campaigned on implementing a \$30 per hour minimum wage, government-run buses and grocery stores and abolishing Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE).

Sanders and Ocasio-Cortez endorsed Mamdani ahead of the election.

Mamdani-backed candidates Darializa Avila Chevalier and Claire Valdez won their congressional races in late June. Young, college-educated voters in densely populated areas formed the core voting bloc for these candidates, an analysis of primary election data found.

Chevalier deleted several tweets from 2020 through 2022, where she criticized libraries for lacking communist books, joked about anti-communist pop culture and reported a tweet criticizing capitalism for creating too much consumer choice.

Democratic Colorado congressional candidate Melat Kiros, a 29-year-old democratic socialist, defeated incumbent Rep. Diana DeGette in Colorado's 1st Congressional District Tuesday. DeGette served in Congress for 29 years, first assuming office in January 1997.

DSA refused to endorse former President Joe Biden or former Vice President Kamala Harris during the 2024 presidential election cycle.

While early DSA leaders like Michael Harrington were pro-Israel, the modern organization became staunchly anti-Israel, accusing the country of committing ethnic cleansing and genocide in Gaza. The major shift came in the 2010s as left-wing groups like Black Lives Matter, Occupy Wall Street and others linked the Palestinian cause to social justice and imperialism issues.

Mamdani received backlash in 2025 for refusing to condemn the phrase, “globalize the intifada,” a pro-Palestinian phrase that is widely seen as a call for violence against Jews. A law firm in New York City fired Kiros in November 2023 after she published an open letter to law firms criticizing the state of Israel.

The House of Representatives censured Tlaib in November 2023 for using the phrase “from the river to the sea,” which has connotations of wiping out Israel. She criticized Biden for supporting Israel and attended several rallies organized by groups critical of Israel.

Many conservatives have rushed to belittle DSA, hoping that doing so will help Republicans win in November’s midterm elections. Former Trump advisor Steve Bannon argued they should take DSA more seriously.

“They’re a national power,” Bannon told Politico. “They have worked below the surface to perfect a ground game and a canvassing operation. It’s too late for the Democrats to recreate that. I told people in the Republican Party and it was dismissed [as] a flash in the pan, it’s clearly just a New York City thing.”

Nobel laureate and economist Paul Krugman suggested during a recent interview that certain tariffs on Chinese vehicles may now be a necessity. Krugman said Saturday during an interview with Bloomberg Television that he thinks having some “conditional tariffs” on Chinese cars are “probably going to be necessary.”

“I don’t think that the Europeans can allow their auto industry to be totally hollowed out,” Krugman said. Still, Krugman also noted that he believes completely “shutting out” Chinese vehicles from the market would be a “bad thing” and also “very costly to consumers.”

“But on the other hand, I have been shocked, not only by my own change of mind, but by ... some of my colleagues,” he said. “People who are longtime advocates of globalization and free trade, who are saying, ‘okay Europe needs to do [something]’ ... really if you like, it’s national security, it’s market disruption, to just allow something as big as the European auto industry to just be overrun, even if consumers would benefit for a while, it’s not 20 years ago anymore.”

Krugman also stated that his stance on tariffs is “a long way from saying that we should have tariffs on everything or that Europeans should have tariffs on everything.” He added that a “much more interventionist position” has now become much more difficult to avoid.

Krugman has previously been an outspoken critic of sweeping tariffs, calling President Donald Trump’s threat to implement higher tariffs on Brazil “grotesquely illegal” in July 2025, NPR reported.

In September 2025, Krugman blasted the Trump administration’s tariff strategy as “complete, utter chaos,” Yahoo Finance reported. Krugman also claimed in a Feb 24, 2026 Substack post that Trump “has the economics of trade deficits fundamentally wrong.”

Trump and Chinese President Xi Jinping reached a “trade and economic deal” in November 2025 which in part states that the U.S. will “lower the tariffs on Chinese imports imposed to curb fentanyl flows by removing 10 percentage points of the cumulative rate, effective November 10, 2025, and will maintain its suspension of heightened reciprocal tariffs on Chinese imports until November 10, 2026,” according to a White House fact sheet.

The White House said in a February 2025 fact sheet that the U.S. imposing tariffs on imports from Mexico, Canada and China is part of a broader effort to hold the countries “accountable to their promises of halting illegal immigration and stopping poisonous fentanyl and other drugs from flowing into our country.”

Additionally, carmakers in China have been vastly outperforming U.S., European and Japanese companies in electric vehicles, battery innovation, design and software, BBC News reported in May.
