BIG SANDY, Texas—Saturday, Oct. 26, was the first church service after the observance of the 2024 Feast of Tabernacles. In my Bible study that day, I gave a presentation titled “Post-Feast Reminders.”

Following are the seven concepts that I shared with the congregation.

## **Talk to God every day**

There are many scriptures that discuss the concept of talking to our Heavenly Father every day. Here are a few.

■ Matthew 6:5-13—The Son of God taught His disciples to pray every day and even gave them an example.

Acknowledging our Father and His name.

Praying for His kingdom.

Praying for His will.

Asking for our daily needs.

Asking for forgiveness—realizing that we should be forgiving other people.

Asking Him to help us avoid temptation.

Asking Him to deliver us from the evil one.

Acknowledging His power and glory.

## **Listen to God every day**

■ Acts 17:11—Study His Bible every day.

## **Enjoy music to set your mood**

■ 1 Samuel 16:16, 23—David’s music helped refresh Saul from the distressing spirit.

## **Recognize people trying to hurt you**

■ 2 Timothy 4:14-15—Paul mentioned how Alexander the coppersmith did him much harm, and he warned them to “beware of him.”

■ Matthew 16:21—The Son of God told His disciples about the elders, chief priests and scribes.

### **Recognize people trying to help you**

■ 2 Timothy 1:16-18—Onesiphorus traveled to Rome to support Paul when he was in prison.

### **Develop a habit of helping people**

■ Hebrews 6:10—God will not forget your labor of love in serving the saints.

■ Luke 14:12-14—Even though you may not be repaid in this life, you will be repaid for your service at the resurrection.

■ 2 Corinthians 1:3-4—Since the Father comforts us, we learn how to comfort others.

■ 2 Corinthians 1:8-10—We trust God, and we set an example to other people for them to trust God.

### **Worship God**

■ Revelation 20:4—We have the honor of worshiping the Father and the Son—instead of worshiping the beast.
