Unless you are brainwashed, you regard the statements "men give birth" and "defund the police" as absurd.

Why, then, do leftists (as opposed to liberals and conservatives) say these things and even believe them?

I think there are two—related—explanations.

One is that the Left seeks to tear down every normative institution. If men give birth, "man" and "woman" no longer mean anything. "Men give birth" means the end of the male-female distinction, the most basic distinction in the human race. Racial distinctions pale in comparison. So do national distinctions.

Marxists support the obliteration of the male-female distinction because the only distinction that matters to Marxists is that of class.

The other explanation is that the endgame of leftism is chaos. It is related to the first explanation, since the obliteration of all distinctions is chaos. Distinctions mean order. Having no distinctions means chaos.

I came to realize the significance of distinctions when writing my commentary on the first five books of the Bible ("The Rational Bible"). The Bible's moral order is dependent on distinctions. Among them are the following.

- Man and God
- Good and evil
- Human and animal
- Holy and profane
- Parent and child
- Man and woman
- Beautiful and ugly

Distinctions are so important to the Judeo-Christian moral order and weltanschauung that making distinctions is what God did for the Six Days. While they are known as the Six Days of Creation, the fact is that after creating the "heavens and the earth," God does little creating. After Genesis 1:1 the only things God creates are the animals listed in 1:21 and the human being (1:27). So, then, what did God do for the remainder of the Six Days? He created order out of chaos.

That's why the second verse of Genesis may well be the second-most important verse in the Bible (Genesis 1:1 is the most important because if you don't accept its premise, none of what follows matters): "And all was null and void," meaning all was chaos.

Chaos is the natural state of the world. The transformation of chaos into order necessitated God.

Order is composed of distinctions. Natural order was dependent on the distinction between night and day and land and sea, and moral and social order was dependent upon the distinctions listed above. And while they are all dependent upon God, the Bible describes only one of them as "created" by God—the human being as male and female.

The Left seeks to obliterate these biblical distinctions:

The Left denies the distinction between man and God. As Marx said, "Man is God." The idea that there is a transcendent Being to which man owes moral obedience is anathema to the Left. Man is to answer only to himself (and ultimately to a left-wing state).

The Left denies the distinction between good and evil. On the Left, there is no objective morality. Good and evil are subjective, determined by the individual and the community.

The Left denies the distinction between human and animal. According to the largest animal rights organization, People for the Ethical Treatment of Animals (PETA), for example, there is no moral difference between a chicken and a human being. They are equally valuable—so much so that, according to PETA, there is no moral difference between a barbecued chicken in America and a cremated Jew in the Holocaust.

The Left denies the difference between the beautiful and the ugly in art. That explains the ugly music and architecture and the meaningless art the art world, led by the Left, has produced for a century.

And now the Left denies the difference between man and woman.

What is this all about? It is all about rejecting the divine order which made civilization possible and returning to chaos. That why "men give birth" is related to "defund the police." Both lead to chaos.

If you ask those who claim that men give birth or who seek to defund the police, "Do you believe in chaos?" most won't know what you're talking about. On a conscious level, chaos is not what the Left seeks.

But it is what the Left creates. The war against Western civilization is a war against distinctions and order. That's why the Left loathes talk about Judeo-Christian and biblical values. These values represent the divine moral and social distinctions and subsequent order that constitute Western civilization.

That's why "men give birth" and "defund the police" are related. Both represent disorder.

Over the course of 90+ minutes, Matt Walsh's captivating and important documentary "What Is a Woman?" never mentions God. It's the equivalent of exploring the truth regarding Tom Brady's NFL career without referencing Bill Belichick.

It's a glaring and telling omission that damns American clergy members far more than Walsh—a courageous faith-inspired public intellectual—and his provocative documentary that explores how and why the question "what is a woman?" became loaded and controversial.

Walsh frames his documentary as a search for truth. Based on his finished product, his hunt for truth never led him to a church or forced one of his interview subjects to reference God, Jesus, or the Bible.

Walsh's film is worldly. It fights a spiritual war on secular terms. This is likely a choice made by Walsh and his Daily Wire collaborators.

"We didn't want the film to be a theological debate or to present the issue as though you have to be religious to disagree with gender ideology," Walsh texted me Sunday afternoon. "That's the approach the left would have wanted us to take. Our fundamental goal was to reveal the irrationality and absurdity of gender ideology."

The left and corporate media have demonized evangelicals, particularly white ones, to the point that Christians have publicly de-emphasized their faith.

It's a trap. The left intentionally makes arguments devoid of logic, facts, and reason so that conservatives foolishly believe they can win public debates without ever invoking the ultimate authority.

It's a political rope-a-dope that baits the left's opponents to flail away at a soft decoy target while never landing a real blow on a crucial issue.

The left loves heated arguments over pronouns, pregnant men, the treatment of unarmed black criminal suspects who resist arrest, and racist, sexist, homophobic microaggressions. Those disputes distract Americans from assessing the damage caused by the 60-year systemic attack on the nuclear family, the foundational element of religious faith.

We're debating what a woman is when we should be asking why the left keeps promoting pointless, divisive debates.

Walsh's documentary ends with his wife providing the simple answer the alleged therapists, social scientists, doctors, and professors evaded throughout the film: "A woman is an adult female."

It's a clever ending. It's not a powerful one.

Before I go on, let me state that the Daily Wire, Matt Walsh, Ben Shapiro, Jeremy Boreing, Candace Owens, Michael Knowles, and Andrew Klavan have no bigger supporter and fan than yours truly. They have aggressively engaged in the political culture war.

My problem is that war is controlled, defined, and graded by the secular industries (media, entertainment, technology) and institutions (academia, politics) that are the sworn enemy of evangelicals' best soldier, Jesus Christ.

That war is Vietnam. It's fought on unwinnable terms for believers. It forbids use of nuclear weapons – prayer, the Holy Spirit, and the gospel. The war we

can win is spiritual. If we win that war, the proper politics will fall into place because the culture will demand it. The U.S. Constitution is misunderstood and reviled today for the same reason gender has been expanded to include the whims of individual feelings and emotions.

America has abandoned a biblical worldview.

God created the man-woman binary. It's in the Bible. It's not up for debate. The confusion over this issue is manmade and satanic. That needed to be stated clearly and concisely in "What Is a Woman?"

Dr. Marci Bowers, America's most prolific transgender surgeon, inadvertently references the satanic origin of transgenderism within the first 10 minutes of the documentary.

"We're altering the physical characteristics of the individual to fit better with a gender identity that is female," Bowers tells Walsh. "The surgeries are quite refined in the sense that not only do they look like female anatomy, but they also function that way for the most part. Certainly it's sort of a Faustian bargain."

A Faustian bargain means a deal with the devil, a trade of the soul for worldly favor. Bowers is an expert in this exchange. He personally made the trade to live "his truth" as a woman.

Fifty minutes into the doc, Walsh and a female psychiatrist, Miriam Grossman, explain that America's gender dysphoria is owed to two wicked men: Alfred Kinsey and John Money.

Kinsey (1894 to 1956) is a celebrated American biologist. He founded the Kinsey Institute for Research in Sex, Gender, and Reproduction at Indiana University. He wrote two infamous books: "Sexual Behavior in the Human Male" and "Sexual Behavior in the Human Female." He's the founding father for normalizing human perversion.

He was an atheist. He was bisexual.

"He wanted to rid society of Judeo-Christian values when it came to sexuality," Grossman told Walsh. "He worked very hard to do that, and I would say he succeeded."

John Money (1921-2006) is a celebrated psychologist. He invented the concepts of gender identity, gender roles, and sexual orientation. He was a pioneer in advocating sexual reassignment. He fought to normalize pedophilia. He argued that boys as young as 10 could engage in consensual sex with men in their 20s and 30s. Money is a founding father of transgenderism.

The gender dysphoria movement is rooted in hostility to religious faith. It's satanic.

Religious faith is rooted in respect for, acceptance of, and pursuit of truth. The absence of God signifies an absence of truth. Hostility to truth signifies a hostility toward God.

Walsh told a University of Tennessee professor that he wanted to get at the truth.

"I'm really uncomfortable with that language of, like, 'getting to the truth,'" Dr. Patrick Grzanka responds. "It sounds deeply transphobic to me. You keep invoking the word, which is condescending and rude."

The war on truth is spiritual. There's zero advantage to avoiding the spiritual aspects.

I thoroughly enjoyed Walsh's documentary. It's compelling. I desperately wanted him to frame the debate in the proper context.

Atheists want to eradicate the remaining biblical principles that define the United States of America. The globalists cannot impose a new world order founded in Marxism and communism—the political theory opposed to religion and the economic system opposed to individual freedom and property ownership—without getting America to submit.

The corporate media calls that explanation a conspiracy theory. Anyone with a layman's understanding of Christianity would call it the gospel truth according to scripture. It's good vs. evil. It's God vs. Satan. It's the oldest, most compelling historical narrative in the history of the planet.

Everything that is good and just about America is derived from the biblically inspired words in our founding documents: "We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with unalienable Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness."

America, the way the founders designed it, will not work as a secular society detached from morality. John Adams said that more than 200 years ago. The enemies of America believe Adams. American Christians, by and large, don't. Our faith is an American luxury item. Our political identity is a necessity, as vital as air and water.

The left promotes gender fluidity, sexual promiscuity, and general immorality as tools to detach Americans from religion, truth, and righteousness. It teaches gender and sexuality to kindergartners, hosts drag queen story hours at libraries, and celebrates Pride Month as a means to groom children and parents.

The parent of a transgender or gay child is more likely to second-guess biblical truth than the parent of straight one. The LGBTQ+ movement is the real replacement theory. Democrats are rebuilding their base back better with puberty blockers and chemical castrations. Republicans will bend to those political winds. It's the nature of politics.

Only God can save us from the madness "What Is a Woman?" exposes.

The documentary put the wrong people in the crosshairs. Christians, most especially ministers, need to be shamed, embarrassed, and ridiculed. Our churches and leaders—the institutions and people that reflect our collective will—bow to politics and the social media matrix far more than truth. We

allow them to choose political allies rather than spiritual ones. We allow them to choose racial idolatry rather than kingdom building.

We no longer believe in the power of the gospel, the good news of Jesus Christ.

Before we answer "what is a woman," we need to relearn the meaning of being Christian. That fundamental understanding will directly lead to a reckoning for the ministers who have cut their own Faustian bargains, transitioning from so-called disciples to political activists.

I spent a lot of time this weekend contemplating "Juneteenth," our newest federal holiday.

I first heard of it in 1985, when a college football teammate from Texas chastised a group of us for being unaware of the celebration. He explained the history of it to us. As a boy from Indiana, I understood his appreciation for Texas history but didn't think it applied to me or my family.

I never celebrated Juneteenth. I never gave it much thought. I've lived in Indiana, South Carolina, Michigan, Missouri, Kansas, California, and Tennessee. No one in any of those states ever invited me to a Juneteenth party.

I suspect most people don't fully comprehend or get Juneteenth. It's a national holiday because of the death of George Floyd, not because our political leaders had a sincere interest in celebrating the emancipation of slaves in Texas or across the South.

■ This weekend, the New York Times ran an op-ed from Casey Gerald, an author and a native of Texas. Here are his opening lines: "I won't pretend Juneteenth has always meant a lot to me. I was born in Texas, as were my parents and most of my kin, all the way back to at least the 19th century, when some of them were enslaved. Still, for most of my life, the day was just another holiday marked on the community calendar—even if it was our day, a day for black Texans. Perhaps one sign that a thing belongs to you is that you take it for granted. The past few years have forced some stronger feelings to the surface."

The "Summer of George Floyd" forced those stronger feelings to the surface.

■ A weekend article in the Washington Post spelled out the impetus for those stronger feelings, writing: "During the summer of 2020, amid the racial-justice protests following the murder of George Floyd, millions of white Americans became aware of Juneteenth for the first time. Some companies announced they would give employees the day off on Juneteenth, and momentum grew to make it a national holiday. Last summer, the U.S. did just that, as President Biden signed a bipartisan bill into law on June 17."

■ David Kaufman, writing in the New York Post, agreed with the Washington Post assessment: "At a time when there is so much rewriting of American history, Juneteenth proves why history should be kept intact. Officially declared a national holiday by Congress last year in the wake of George Floyd's 2020 murder, the day marks the emancipation of black slaves by President Abraham Lincoln in January 1863. As we prepare to celebrate it for the first time as a nation on Monday, it feels as important as the Fourth of July."

Juneteenth's connection to the George Floyd riots undermines the holiday's ability to unify Americans. A lack of unifying messaging undermines the success and purpose of a national holiday.

What's the purpose of Juneteenth?

■ Opal Lee, known as the "grandmother of Juneteenth," offered this explanation: "Juneteenth asks Americans to recognize that our nation's principles are neither grossly hypocritical nor naively aspirational. We have inherited lofty yet practical ideals, and it falls to us to implement them as best we can. In 1865, that meant fighting attempts to reimpose slavery through violence. In 2022, it means opposing new forms of violence, whether it is violence that comes from within a community or violence perpetrated by the police."

I like the first part of Lee's explanation. It's unifying and inspirational. But the second half falls flat. She analogizes slavery to violent police misconduct. The end of slavery freed 2.5 million black people. Slavery was codified into law and custom. The rare instances of illegal police violence are not backed by law or even custom. They're aberrations.

■ Casey Gerald summarized his thoughts on Juneteenth this way: "Let us grieve for our forebears and feel deep gratitude as we think of the enormous price our people paid so we could be free. Let us remember that despite the degradation of slavery, they lived fully human lives, too. They laughed. They loved. They dreamed. They ate sweet treats. Let us pray to them and say, this year and always: Thank you."

Gerald's definition leaves out the price paid by the hundreds of thousands of Union soldiers whose enormous price included the sacrifice of their lives. Gerald wants a black national holiday, not a unifying one.

My point is, as black people, we can't fully explain or justify the Juneteenth holiday. Most black people did not care until George Floyd died.

The black female mayor of New Orleans, LaToya Cantrell, best represents our confusion. Over the weekend, she unveiled a monument she had erected at Lafayette Square in celebration of Juneteenth. The monument is an afro pick with a clenched fist. She said the sculpture represents the freedoms we've gained. New Orleans' next sculpture will be of a durag and a can of Murray's hair grease.

Let me take a crack at defining Juneteenth.

American black people did a lot of celebrating in 1865.

Confederate General Robert E. Lee surrendered to Union General Ulysses S. Grant on April 9 of that year, ending the Civil War and kicking off the official death of slavery.

Twenty-two days later, more than 10,000 freed slaves in Charleston, South Carolina, held a parade honoring deceased Union soldiers. The event is credited with starting the Memorial Day tradition.

In June 1865, Union Army General Gordon Granger arrived in Galveston, Texas, and enforced Abraham Lincoln's Emancipation Proclamation. Black Texans adopted June 19th as a day to celebrate their freedom.

In early December, the United States ratified the 13th Amendment, abolishing slavery.

The year 1865 is as important to American history as 1776. America was reborn, reimagined, and resurrected from the dead. The year marks black Americans' central role in this country's march toward freedom and exceptionalism. The African-American journey has been America's north star, its moral compass.

The fact that Juneteenth is such a divisive and polarizing issue speaks to how far this nation and its citizens have strayed from our shared moral struggle, purpose, and values.

I wish we could rebrand Juneteenth as 1865 Day. We could spend the day honoring the people who sacrificed everything for America to experience a rebirth. Right now, it's a celebration of George Floyd. I feel sorry for George Floyd. I have no interest in celebrating him.

Within the month we anticipate a verdict will be issued that overturns Roe vs. Wade, setting in motion an evisceration of abortion access across the so-called United States.

This is an event that should inspire rage in millions of people who can get pregnant—and yet, the response thus far has been tepid.

We have agonized over this apparent absence of indignation. Why is it that we are so afraid to unleash hell upon those who are destroying us? Fear of state repression is valid, but this goes deeper than that.

Your anger has been stolen from you.

To this we say: no more. We need to get angry.

We need the state to feel our full wrath.

We need to express this madness fully and with ferocity. We need to quit containing ourselves.

■ We need them to be afraid of us.

Last week, an evil creature slaughtered 19 children and two teachers in their classroom in Texas. While some may call this horrific act "senseless" or "random," we know that's not the case.

We know that this was an act of male domination and patriarchal violence, meant to make women, children and teachers live in fear.

We know it is deeply connected to the reproductive violence about to be unleashed on this land by an illegitimate institution founded in white male supremacy.

We cannot think of a clearer example in this time of the need for autonomously organized self-defense networks.

We cannot think of a clearer example of the desperate need for those who get pregnant to learn how to confront misogynistic violence directly.

We also believe this unlearning of our self-containment can begin in the streets when we organize alongside one another to confront state forces of evil and domination.

Several weeks ago, we watched and waited as self-proclaimed "feminist organizations' and non-profits took the lead on arranging their demure little rallies for freedom.

We were told to let them handle it, and to defer to the political machinery that has thus far failed to secure our liberation.

In a world where the news media has an attention span of about 24 hours on their best day, we knew these hollow gestures would fail to capture attention.

We knew we were witnessing counterinsurgency in action.

We cannot sit idly by anymore while our anger is yet again channeled into Democratic party fundraisers and peace parades with the police.

We were even told we must cooperate with them because they work alongside abortion providers and clinic escorts . . . a group of people who, at this moment in time, cannot possibly risk their lives or their livelihoods any further than they already are.

We honor these providers and their service.

We do not honor those who would use them as a shield against direct and militant action.

We believe the greatest honor we could give them would be to act meaningfully in their name.

The time to act was decades ago. The next best time is now.

■ Whatever form your fury takes, the first step is feeling it.

The next step is carrying that anger out into the world and expressing it physically.

Consider this your call to action.

On the night the final ruling is issued—a specific date we cannot yet predict, but we know is arriving imminently—we are asking for courageous hearts to come out after dark.

Whoever you are and wherever you are, we are asking for you to do what you can to make your anger known.

We have selected a time of 8:00 p.m. for actions nationwide to begin, but know that this is a general guideline. There may be other considerations involved in planning time and place.

We do not claim to speak for every community or crew. We are simply calling out to you. And we hope you answer our cries.

To this cis male allies who would be interested in joining us in the streets, we say: You are certainly welcome, but you must use your privilege to shield and support us in a way that also enables us to get angry.

Do not police us. Do not tell us what is and isn't appropriate. But do aid us when we are in need.

■ We must also say: Do not wait until the verdict arrives to organize.

Make plans now. Take action now.

It is not enough to share images on Twitter and Instagram (though that is still important to do). We cannot sustain this movement any longer with the same few hundred people who have been beaten down over and over again. We must not only this call on social media, but reach out to communities who may not be in touch with 'radical circles' online.

■ Mass action requires mass outreach.

We would not be issuing this call if we not believe in our bones that this kind of action is possible.

We have witnessed the women of Argentina, Mexico and Poland organize autonomously for their reproductive liberation. We know it can be done—but we need every soul reading this to do their part.

To those who work to oppress us: If abortion isn't safe, you aren't either. We are everywhere.
