Twenty miles north of Jerusalem, five Texas Red Angus cows chew on grass, oblivious to the fact that their mere presence in Israel was cited by Hamas as a reason for its massacre of Israeli civilians on October 7. The terror organization’s spokesperson says the cows were a justification for the attack, stating that bringing them to Israel was “an aggression” based on a “detestable religious myth.”

In Ancient Shiloh (located in Samaria, also referred to as the West Bank) Moriyah Shapira proudly showcases the red heifers – which were brought to Israel after a long, tedious search. The animals comply with a very specific set of characteristics outlined in verses in the Book of Numbers in the Old Testament.

The Hebrew Bible states that red heifers are necessary for a purification ceremony to enter the Temple or its portable predecessor (the Tabernacle). Moses performed a ceremony with red heifer ashes that were used for the Tabernacle in the Sinai before the Jews entered Israel after his death.

Hamas has called the importation of the red cows an act of “aggression” because it falsely believes that the presence of the cows may ignite the rebuilding of the Temple (which the group thinks would end Arab control of the Temple Mount, where the Al-Aqsa Mosque is located).

But rabbis say the return of the red cows does not mean the Temple will be rebuilt anytime soon.

Shapira says bringing the cows to Israel (and specifically to Shiloh) is an “amazing thing” because it’s the last place the Tabernacle stood before King Solomon built the Temple in Jerusalem – according to the Bible.

Shapira (the Chief Content Officer of Ancient Shiloh) said: “We’re here where the Tabernacle stood for the first time – for 369 years in the first capital city of Israel. We brought here the five red heifers from Texas. It’s an amazing thing and people are coming from all over to see them.”

Shapira’s role with Ancient Shiloh includes educating the thousands of guests who visit each year to see the archaeological site of the Tabernacle. Visitors are able to immerse themselves in the setting of several Biblical stories – including Joshua dividing the tribes of Israel and Hannah praying for a child.

While there is much uproar over what bringing five red cows to Israel means, Shapira says the plan is to open an educational visitor center in Shiloh where people can visit them.

She said: “The idea is that we’ll have people here from all over to see Shiloh . . . and to learn about the subject of red heifers, which is very spiritual and interesting and amazing. They will enter the visitor center, and then they’ll see a movie, and the screen will go up, and from a window, they’ll see the red heifers.”

Shapira shut down conspiracies spread on social media about plans to kill the red heifers for a ceremony this year.

She said: “There are no specific plans when to make the ceremony of the red heifers. That is something very important so it needs to be agreed on first of all, among rabbis and Israelis, the people of Israel, and then among the nations. We want it to be agreeable and in a peaceful way so it will bring a blessing to the world.”

Arrived from Texas

The red heifers were purchased from a Christian rancher who began raising the Red Angus breed 30 years ago in the hopes of fulfilling Biblical prophecy, according to Shapira.

As calves, the cows were brought as pets with special government permission to avoid the restriction against importing livestock. Shapira says it cost \$500,000 to bring them here, and that cost as well as the cost of caring for the cows and building a visitor center is fueled by donations.

Upon arrival, the cows were in an undisclosed location until making their way to Ancient Shiloh – where they are now well-guarded due to threats against their lives.

Here are their names.

- Segula – (Protection)

- Geula – (Redemption)
- Tikva – (Hope)
- Nechama – (Comfort)
- Techiya – (Rebirth)

The heifers need to fit the exact physical conditions outlined in the Hebrew Bible – including having every single hair on their body the perfect color. Three of the cows so far have been disqualified because a few hairs are not red. Shapira says they plan to breed the disqualified cows to create a larger herd in Israel.

Red heifer ceremony

Conducting a red heifer ceremony is controversial in rabbinic circles, and there is far from a consensus over whether it can even be done – according to the Temple Institute, which provides rabbinical supervision for the cows.

“There is no plan right now for using a kosher red heifer, killing it and turning it into ashes,” said Yitzchak Reuven (the director of international development for the Temple Institute). “We will only do this when the time is right, because there is no point in doing it if the Jewish and rabbinic world won’t accept it.”

Reuven said that his Institute has spent 20 years educating and dedicating resources to ensure that the “mitzvah” (the Hebrew word for commandment) can be done properly when the day comes.

Reuven emphasized that the Jewish religion does not believe a red heifer being in Israel means that the messiah necessarily has arrived or that having one will force the messiah to arrive.

He said: “There is tremendous interest in the Christian world because they see it as part of the prophecy and will lead to the return of Jesus” – adding that there are hundreds of thousands of red heifer candidates in the world (citing the Red Angus and the Highland Cattle in Scotland).

Only nine red heifers have ever been slaughtered and burned to create ashes needed for purification since the time of Moses – according to the prolific Torah scholar Maimonides.

Reuven added: “We do not want to ignite World War III. It’s a mitzvah in the Torah and we want to be able to fulfill it and it shouldn’t be seen as a threat to anyone. People should calm down a bit because we’re talking about a heifer and a ceremony that is 4,000 years old.”

While most offerings outlined in the Bible are to be eaten by priests and others, the red heifer is to be burnt completely to ash.

Hamas response

Reuven took note that Hamas claimed the red heifers were a motivation for its October 7

massacre of Israelis.

Reuven said: “Until recently I don’t think the Muslim world took much interest in it, but after October 7 Hamas called their massacre the Al-Aqsa flood, they added that the preparation for the red heifer is one of their motivating factors. I don’t think they need any motivation to slaughter Jews, but they’re piggybacking on the red heifer in order to raise the volume.”

Despite Hamas’ rhetoric and criticism from other religions, the red heifer is not the key to begin rebuilding the Temple, according to Reuven.

Reuven said: “The main thing we need to build a Temple is that the Jewish people want to build a Temple. I don’t endorse the scenario that there will be a big war and then we will build a Temple. It’s supposed to be a peaceful place and will be done peacefully, and a place for prayer for all nations and we will need a consensus of the major religions.”

“Temple denial” is a known practice amongst those who seek to deny any historical presence for Jews in Israel – leading to a denial of Israel’s right to exist.

As with every year, Tisha B’Av, the Jewish day of mourning the destruction of the two Temples and the exile of Jews from Judea by the Romans in the year 70 CE, sparked controversy on the Temple Mount as Jewish worshippers defied the status quo and Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu’ directives and praying and prostrating in the holy place.

On the backdrop of the political, religious, and diplomatic prospects, Tisha B’Av also catalyzes a well-established practice across the pro-Palestinian world, nicknamed “Temple denial.”

This practice provides anti-Zionist voices with a platform to deny the indigeneity of the Jewish people to Israel – negating empirical historical facts – all in an attempt to strip Israel of its right to exist.

An article was written by Ali Mohammad Al-Salabi – chair of the International Union of Muslim Scholars (which is seen as a supreme clerical authority for the Muslim Brotherhood).

The organization was previously led by Sheikh Yusuf Al-Qaradawi – who endorsed and promoted suicide bombings against Israelis. Al-Salabi’s article also makes the claim that the area was Islamic “prior to even the strongest evidence provided by the Jews.”

In the article, Al-Salabi reached the rather unsurprising conclusion that the Temples never existed – further pondering: “How strange that you Jews . . . claim that the temple is a symbol of your existence and your ancient state . . . in Palestine!”

On a popular website named Islam Q and A, one user asked regarding the historical truth of Solomon’s Temple. The response writer suggested that the story of Solomon’s Temple is a “fabrication by the Jews,” adding that no credible source confirms its existence or construction by Solomon.

He also alleged: “Despite extensive archaeological excavations since 1968, no evidence of Solomon’s Temple has been found – reinforcing the notion that the temple is a myth crafted by the authors of the Bible to strengthen Jewish claims to Jerusalem and encourage their return.”

Despite Temple denial being a common practice nowadays, this was not always the case.

- A well-known pamphlet distributed by the Waqf in Jerusalem back in 1929 shows the local supreme Muslim authority highlighting that Temple Mount’s “identity with the site of Solomon’s Temple is beyond dispute. This, too, is the spot (according to the universal belief) on which David built there an altar unto the Lord and offered burnt offerings and peace offerings.”
- Likewise, many traditional Muslim commentators referred to the Temples in their exegesis – including 14th century Damascus scholar Ibn Katheer and 10th century scholar from Baghdad, Al-Tabari.

What are they writing about Voldemort in the newspapers? Nothing. The Daily Prophet (the newspaper of record in the Harry Potter world) doesn’t actually report that Voldemort is back.

Instead, they spread a bunch of gossip about Harry Potter, insinuating that he’s making up the whole thing because he’s desperate for attention.

Sure, that’s fiction. But the real life press does the same stuff.

Here’s an egregious example from the past few years. In late 2021, Business Insider posted an article about how Dave Portnoy (the founder of “Barstool Sports”) was basically sexually assaulting women. For 8 months, they reached out to every single woman in his life. Most of them spoke well of Portnoy – and Business Insider ignored them. Eventually they found 2 women who were willing to say something bad about Portnoy. Once they found the second, they stopped doing interviews and prepared to go to press. Then, they published the article the day before Penn National Gaming (“Barstool Sports” parent company) was due to publish its earnings report. Within 2 days, Portnoy shared evidence that both the women were lying.

Business Insider did not issue an apology or correct its article. [In fact, Business Insider wrote a second article, which Portnoy again proved was wrong.]

This is an extreme, but the media lies about basically everything.

Everyone admits that Russian newspapers lie. Everyone admits that Chinese newspapers lie. Liberals admit that Fox News lied, and conservatives admit that CNN lies. But somehow, they never realize that their own side is lying, too.

There are 2 reasons why most newspaper articles are wrong.

- The first reason is that journalists don't look into the subjects they cover that hard.
- The second reason is that journalists aren't incentivized to tell the truth – they are incentivized to tell entertaining stories and spread propaganda. Entertaining stories get them more clicks and spreading propaganda gets them more power.

The press usually doesn't outright lie, because someone could call them out on it, and they they could get in hot water.

Instead the press lies in subtle ways.

- They omit facts that hurt their narrative.
- They shine a light on facts that push their narrative.
- They write in a tone of voice that implies stuff that isn't true.

Here is one example of how you can “spin” a story.

- If you want to write a piece about how knee doctors are the greatest doctors ever and how they are miracle workers helping people walk again, you can say: “90% of knee surgeries are successful.”
- If you want to write a piece about how knee doctors are bumbling, incompetent nincompoops who are endangering people's lives, you can say: “10% of knee surgeries fail.”

Those two sentences carry the same information. But they imply opposite things – the first makes surgery sound safe, the second makes surgery sound unsafe.

Consider the differences to describe someone sweating.

- “Sweating” sounds gross.
- “Perspiring” sounds scientific and neutral.
- “Glowing” sounds like they are some sort of Greek goddess.

People often tell me that I seem more informed about current events than the average person.

Why am I so informed about current events? Because I don't follow the news, which lies about current events. Instead, read books or listen to podcasts.
