There are moments when a single geographic choke point becomes the focal point of global upheaval. The Strait of Hormuz is such a point.

This narrow maritime passage (approximately 40 kilometers wide) under normal circumstances allows for the flow of some 21 million barrels of oil per day – about 20% of global consumption – as well as a significant share of the liquefied natural gas (LNG) market.

When such an artery is disrupted, even partially, the consequences are not regional but global.

Recent developments in the Persian Gulf illustrate this sharply. The ongoing confrontation between Iran and the United States and Israel has brought about a qualitative shift: from Tehran’s familiar rhetorical threat to close the strait to a partial implementation in practice.

This was not a formal declaration of a full blockade, but rather the creation of an operational reality characterized by high risk, uncertainty, and exceptional insurance costs.

The practical result is a “soft closure”: the strait is not completely blocked, but it has ceased to function as a regular global export artery.

Effectively, some ships are still passing through – but at times only in return for payments amounting to millions of dollars, constituting unofficial “transit fees.”

- Many shipping companies are avoiding the passage altogether.
- Others are freezing sailing operations.
- Hundreds of vessels are waiting on both sides of the strait.

In economic terms, this constitutes a significant disruption to the global flow of energy.

Oil markets

The immediate impact is evident in the oil market. When the supply of tens of millions of barrels per day is impaired, a gap emerges between supply and demand, and prices respond accordingly.

Simultaneously, the Gulf States are activating backup mechanisms.

- Saudi Arabia, for example, has significantly increased oil flow through the King Fahd Industrial Port in Yanbu on the Red Sea. It has even succeeded in diverting a substantial share of its exports, amounting to tens of percent of the volume normally passing through Hormuz.
- The United Arab Emirates is also making use of overland pipeline infrastructure to the Port of Fujairah, outside the Persian Gulf.
- And Iraq is diverting part of its oil through Turkey to the Mediterranean Sea.

Liquefied natural gas

Alongside the oil market, the liquefied natural gas market has also been significantly affected.

Qatar, one of the world’s leading exporters, depends almost entirely on passage through the Strait of Hormuz in order to transport LNG to markets in Asia and Europe.

Strategic and security implications

On the geopolitical level, a complex reality is taking shape. A certain easing in the purchase of Russian oil (including cargoes under sanctions) indicates a willingness to circumvent international mechanisms in order to ease shortages. This move is causing friction among Western countries and is even undermining the price-cap mechanism on Russian oil.

Concurrently, pressure is mounting to increase the international military presence in the Gulf to ensure freedom of navigation or to employ a significant military force to ensure freedom of navigation in the Strait of Hormuz.

Naval escort frameworks, maritime policing, and an enhanced military presence may become a permanent feature of the region.

In the long term, the picture may change fundamentally.

Already, trends can be identified.

- Increased investment in overland pipelines
- Diversification of energy sources (the U.S., Africa, the North Sea)
- An acceleration of the transition to renewable energy and local sources

In other words, the more the world learns to reduce its dependence on the Strait of Hormuz, the more Iran's ability to use it as a tool of pressure will erode. What provides a tactical advantage in the short term may become a strategic disadvantage in the long one.

A test for the global system

The lesson is not new. Since the 1973 energy crisis, the world has known that excessive dependence on a single geographic choke point is a recipe for prolonged instability. However, the current crisis gives this lesson renewed relevance in an era of deep globalization: geopolitical tension and an accelerating energy transition.

Ultimately, the Strait of Hormuz is not merely a shipping lane – it is a test.

The global economy's ability to cope with structural vulnerability and the international system's capacity to respond to threats against freedom of navigation are being tested.

- The current partial blockage is not only a crisis – it is also an opportunity.
- It is an opportunity to reshape the global energy system so that it becomes more diversified, more resilient, and less vulnerable to geopolitical pressure.

- “We condemn in the strongest terms recent attacks by Iran on unarmed commercial vessels in the Gulf, attacks on civilian infrastructure including oil and gas installations, and the defacto closure of the Strait of Hormuz by Iranian forces.”
- “We express our deep concern about the escalating conflict. We call on Iran to cease immediately its threats, laying of mines, drone and missile attacks and other attempts to block the Strait to commercial shipping, and to comply with the UN Security Council Resolution 2817.”
- “Freedom of navigation is a fundamental principle of international law, including under the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea.”
- “The effects of Iran’s actions will be felt by people in all parts of the world, especially the most vulnerable.”
- “Consistent with UNSC Resolution 2817, we emphasize that such interference with international shipping and the disruption of global energy supply chains constitute a threat to international peace and security. In this regard, we call for an immediate comprehensive moratorium on attacks on civilian infrastructure, including oil and gas installations.”
- “We express our readiness to contribute to appropriate efforts to ensure safe passage through the Strait. We welcome the commitment of nations who are engaging in preparatory planning.”
- “We welcome the International Energy Agency decision to authorize a coordinated release of strategic petroleum reserves. We will take other steps to stabilize energy markets, including working with certain producing nations to increase output.”
- “We will also work to provide support for the most affected nations, including the United Nations and the IFIS.”

- “Maritime security and freedom of navigation benefits all countries. We call on all states to respect international law and uphold the fundamental principles of international prosperity and security.”

Robert Mueller is dead, but his toxic legacy lives on in the destroyed lives of the innocent victims targeted by the Russia collusion probe that bears his name.

To understand why President Trump had no kind words for the former FBI director when he died over the weekend at age 81, you have to understand the human toll on the president and dozens of his friends and allies.

Who knows whether Mueller, who had Parkinson’s, was in command of all his faculties when he appointed special counsel at age 72?

But the deep state evildoers on his team knew exactly what they were doing when they used his formerly prestigious reputation to pervert the course of justice for their “Get Trump” frolic.

In the end, the Mueller gang found no Russian collusion by the Trump campaign, but the crippled Trump’s first presidency anyway. And their witch hunt continued through the Biden administration and even into last year – through covert surveillance, subpoenas, debanking and crippling legal costs that were incurred even without charges being brought.

Independent journalist Catherine Herridge’s searing interview with longtime Trump ally Michael Caputo last week gives you a glimpse into the Kafkaesque nightmare he endured at the hands of Mueller and his henchmen – such as Andrew Weissman, Brandon Van Grack, Zainab Ahmad, Aaron Zelinsky and Walter Giardina.

The FBI investigation into Caputo only ended after he made a personal appeal to Trump last December, he says.

There are so many others like Caputo who deserve accountability.

First come the revelations. Gradually, we are learning more details about the unprofessional atmosphere in the Mueller office.

One of the central players was Giardina, a “very liberal” FBI agent who was fired from the bureau last year, according to new insights from a colleague who worked with him on the Mueller probe.

Giardina, who performed financial tasks in the special counsel office, was outspokenly biased against Trump, was convinced the lurid allegations in the discredited Steele dossier were true, and believed the president was a Russian agent, said his former colleague, who has been interviewed by the FBI.

The unnamed agent said: “Walter Giardina was very liberal in his politics and very biased in his discussions about political matters and in how he felt about people in the Trump administration. Giardina was convinced this [Russian collusion] was the biggest investigation in the bureau and was a true believer. Giardina read and believed the Steele dossier.”

The “Steele dossier” was a Hillary Clinton campaign smear sheet concocted by British former spy-for-hire Christopher Steele that falsely alleged Trump had participated in “golden showers” with prostitutes in a Moscow hotel and was being blackmailed by Vladimir Putin.

These new revelations about Giardina’s anti-Trump hostility confirm previous claims by Senator Chuck Grassley (R-Iowa) that he was the FBI’s “Agent Zero,” who kept popping up in numerous anti-Trump operations.

Giardina played a “significant role” in the prosecution of Trump advisers Peter Navarro, Dan Scavino and Roger Stone, the Hillary Clinton cases, and in various “Get Trump” operations such as Arctic Frost, Crossfire Hurricane – and Mueller’s investigation, for which he received an award.

Grassley last year wrote to AG Pam Bondi and FBI Director Kash Patel, providing whistleblower allegations of Giardina’s “misconduct while on the taxpayers’ dime that ought to be investigated.”

The fact that Giardina harbored animosity toward Trump and his allies comes as no surprise to one of his victims, Navarro, a trade adviser to Trump in both presidencies.

Giardina arrested Navarro at Reagan Airport in Washington, DC, in 2022 as he was about to board a plane.

“He wouldn’t let me call a lawyer,” Navarro recalls bitterly, after spending four months in prison in 2024 for failing to comply with subpoenas from Nancy Pelosi’s January 6 star chamber. “He put me in leg irons for a misdemeanor. He perp-walked my wife. Giardina is the Forrest Gump of anti-Trumpism in the deep state, and he needs to be held accountable. He’s the single most important witness to uncover the orchestrated attack on Donald Trump and his lieutenants.”

Navarro’s assessment appears to be buttressed by the new recollections provided by Giardina’s former Mueller colleague.

Giardina has retired into obscurity, but he just might be drawn into the “grand conspiracy” investigation led by US Attorney Jason Reding Quinones in the Southern District of Florida.

Disgraced former FBI Director James Comey was subpoenaed last week, according to Axios, among at least 130 other former Obama-era intelligence and FBI officials accused of anti-Trump weaponization sins.

Let’s hope Quinones probe brings accountability – before the Democrats seize the reins again and do even worse.
