 Title "Global Restoration and Personal Restoration"

	Daniel 7:23-27 – calamity and restoration
Dan. 7:23-25	calamity
23	the 4 th beast – a 4 th kingdom on earth – shall be different from all other kingdoms – and shall devour the whole earth – trample it and break it in pieces
24	10 horns are 10 kings – who shall arise from this kingdom – and another shall arise after them – he shall be different from the first ones, and shall subdue 3 kings
25	3 behaviors
	 Speak pompous words against the Most High Persecute ("wear out") the saints of the Most High Intend to change times and law
26-27	after calamity – comes restoration
26	but the court shall be seated – and they shall take away his dominion – to consume and destroy it forever
27	then the kingdom and dominion, and the greatness of the kingdom under the whole heaven shall be given to the people (the saints of the Most High) – His kingdom is an everlasting kingdom – all dominions shall serve and obey Him
	Book of Revelation – calamity and restoration
Rev. 14:12	here is the patience of the saints – here are those who keep the commandments of God and the faith of Jesus
13	then I heard a voice from heaven saying to me – "write: 'blessed are the dead who die in the Lord from now on" – the Spirit says: "yes, that they may rest from their labors, and their works follow them"
Rev. 20:4	I say thrones, and they that sat on them – judgment was committed to them
	 I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded for behavior witness to the Son of God and for the word of God not worshiped the beast or his image not received his mark on their foreheads or hands
5-6	blessed and holy is he who has part in 1 st resurrection – second death has no power – priests of Father and Son reigning for 1,000 years

John 16:19-33 – promise of restoration

John 16:19	Son of God – are you inquiring about the phrase (in a little while, you shall
	not see Me; in a little, you shall see Me)?
20	you will weep and lament, but the world will rejoice – you will be
	sorrowful, but your sorrow will be turned into joy
21	a woman in labor has sorrow – after the birth, she focuses on the baby
22	you now have sorrow, but I will see you again – and your heart shall
	rejoice – and your joy no one will take from you
23-24	you will have – answered prayers
25	up until now, figurative language – soon, plainly
26	Son of God – you will ask in My name
27	Son of God – the Father loves you, because you have loved Me
28	Son of God – I came from the Father and I go to the Father
31	Son of God asked – do you now believe?
32	Son of God – you will be scattered and will leave me alone – but I am not
	alone, because the Father is with Me
33	Son of God – these things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have
	peace – in the world, you will have tribulations – but be of good
	cheer. I have overcome the world
