| 1 Cor. 1:1 | by Paul – called to be an apostle of Jesus Christ through the will of God and Sosthenes our brother |
| 2 | to the Church of God at Corinth – to those who are sanctified in Christ
Jesus – called to be saints – who call upon the name of Jesus Christ our Lord |
| 3 | grace and peace to you – from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ |
| 4-8 | I thank God for you |
| 9 | God is faithful – by whom you were called into the fellowship of His Son, Jesus Christ our Lord |
| 10 | notice the wording <ul style="list-style-type: none">“I plead with you, brethren”“by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ”“that you all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions among you”“but that you be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment” |
| 11 | he found out about contention from Chloe |
| 12 | what was the contention? <ul style="list-style-type: none">“I am of Paul”“I am of Apollos”“I am of Cephas”“I am of Christ” |
| 13 | “Is Christ divided?”
“Was Paul crucified for you?”
“Were you baptized in the name of Paul?” |

| 1 Cor. 3:1 | I could not speak to you as to a spiritual person – I had to speak to you as |

to a carnal person – as to a babe in Christ
 2 I fed you with milk and not solid food – until now, you were not able to
 receive it – even now, you are still not able
 3 for you are still carnal – how? – there are envy, strife and divisions among
 you – are you not carnal and behaving like mere men?
 4 for you say
 “I am of Paul” and “I am of Apollos”
 “Are you not carnal?”
 5 servants – as the Lord gives
 6-7 I planted – Apollos watered – God gave the increase
 8 people who plant and water – receive his own reward
 15 if anyone’s work is burned, he will suffer loss – but, he himself will be
 saved – yet, so as through fire
 1 Cor. 4:4 “He who judges me is the Lord”
 5 “judge nothing before the time”
 1 Cor. 5:9-13 there is a time to withdraw from people
 1 Cor. 8:9 beware, lest somehow this liberty of yours becomes a stumbling block to
 those who are weak
 12 when you thus sin against the brethren and wound their weak conscience,
 you sin against Christ
 1 Cor. 10:31 whatever you do, do all to the glory of God
 32 seek not to offend the Jews, the Greeks or the Church of God
 1 Cor. 11:17 giving some correction
 18 “I hear that there are divisions among you”
 19 “there must also be factions among you, that those who are approved may
 be recognized among you”
 .
 The problem with “division” = often NOT what people believe
 The problem with “division” = usually how people treat each other
 2 Tim. 2:14 not striving about words
 15 diligent – to present yourself approved to God – a worker who does not
 need to be ashamed – rightly dividing the word of truth
 16 shun profane and idle babblings
 19 the solid foundation of God – the Lord knows those who are His – let
 everyone who names the name of Christ, depart from iniquity
 1 Cor. 13:1-3 if I have not love.....
 1 Cor. 15:24 the Son will put an end to all rule, all authority & all power
 28 the Son subjects Himself to the Father – that God may be all in all
