 - 1 Corinthians 1:10 is Not about group think
 - 1 Corinthians 1:10 is Not about the leaders telling you what to believe
 - 1 Corinthians 1:10 is Not about someone establishing a hierarchy over you

Let's look at the background leading up to verse 10 1 Cor. 1:1 by Paul – called to be an apostle of Jesus Christ through the will of God and Sosthenes our brother 2 to the Church of God at Corinth – to those who are sanctified in Christ Jesus – called to be saints – who call upon the name of Jesus Christ

- our Lord
 grace and peace to you from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ
- 4-8 I thank God for you
- 9 God is faithful by whom you were called into the fellowship of His Son, Jesus Christ our Lord
- 10 notice the wording
 - "I plead with you, brethren"
 - "by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ"
 - "that you all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions among you"

"but that you be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment"

- he found out about contention from Chloe
- what was the contention?
 - "I am of Paul"
 - "I am of Apollos"
 - "I am of Cephas"
 - "I am of Christ"
- "Is Christ divided?"
 - "Was Paul crucified for you?"
 - "Were you baptized in the name of Paul?"
- 1 Cor. 3:1 I could not speak to you as to a spiritual person I had to speak to you as

	to a carnal person – as to a babe in Christ	
2	I fed you with milk and not solid food – until now, you were not able to	
	receive it – even now, you are still not able	
3	for you are still carnal – how? – there are envy, strife and divisions among	
	you – are you not carnal and behaving like mere men?	
4	for you say	
	"I am of Paul" and "I am of Apollos"	
	"Are you not carnal?"	
5	servants – as the Lord gives	
6-7	I planted – Apollos watered – God gave the increase	
8	people who plant and water – receive his own reward	
15	if anyone's work is burned, he will suffer loss – but, he himself will be	
	saved – yet, so as through fire	
1 Cor. 4:4	"He who judges me is the Lord"	
5	"judge nothing before the time"
