	A few quick comments This afternoon, Charlie Kirk was assassinated. That event has produced 2 reactions inside me – anger & sadness Here are two verses – about my anger and my sadness
Mark 3:5	the Son of God looked around at them with anger – being grieved by the hardness of their hearts – he healed the man
6	the Pharisees went out and immediately plotted with the Herodians agains Him – how they might destroy Him
Luke 23:27	people followed Him – women mourned and lamented Him
28	"daughters of Jerusalem, do not weep for Me, but weep for yourselves and for your children"
