Matt. 6:16-18 Luke 5:33-35	when you fast "why don't Your disciples fast?" – "they will fast in those days"
Luke 18:9-14	Pharisees fasted improperly –
	 fasting – should be about repentance
	 fasting – should be about a relationship with the Father
Acts 13:3	fasted and prayed – before they sent out servants
Acts 14:23	prayed with fasting – when appointing "elders" (servants) in every church
1 Cor. 7:5	fasting and prayer – a reason to delay marital love
