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· The Tabernacle in Exodus 25-27

Exod. 25:2	offerings – to be given willingly
8	“let them make Me a sanctuary, that I may dwell among them”
9	the pattern of the tabernacle – and the pattern of all its furnishings
10-16	the ark
17-21	the mercy seat – put the mercy seat on top of the ark
22	“and there I will meet with you, and I will speak with you from above the mercy seat – from between the two cherubim (which are on the ark of the Testimony) – about everything which I will give your in commandment to the children of Israel”
Exod. 26:33	and you shall hang the veil from the clasps – then you shall bring the ark of the Testimony in there, behind the veil – the veil shall be a divider for you between the holy place and the Most High
34	shall put the mercy seat upon the ark of the Testimony in the Most Holy

· The Priesthood in Exodus 28-30

Exod. 28:1	take Aaron (your brother) and his 4 sons – minister to Lord as a priest
2-4	holy garments
5-43	other physical accessories – (vest – breastplate – other clothes)
Exod. 29:1-41	instructions about sacrifices
42	a burnt offering at the door of the tabernacle of meeting before the Lord – where I will meet with you – to speak with you
43	there, I will meet with the children of Israel – and the tabernacle shall be sanctified by My glory
44	I will consecrate the tabernacle of meeting and the altar – I will consecrate both Aaron & his sons – to minister unto Me as priests
45	I will dwell among the children of Israel – and I will be their God
46	and they shall know that I am the Lord their God – who brought them out of the land of Egypt – that I may dwell among them

· The Priesthood in Hebrews 2–7

Heb. 2:17	a merciful and faithful High Priest
18	suffered – being tempted
Heb. 3:1	Apostle and High Priest
Heb. 4:14-15	High Priest – tempted in all points
Heb. 5:1-10	priesthood of Melchizedek
Heb. 7:1-18	priesthood of Melchizedek
11	if perfection came through the Levitical priesthood, there would be no need of another priest after the order of Melchizedek
12	the priesthood was changed – a change in the law – (what law? – verse 13)
13	not through a physical tribe
23	there were many priests – because they kept dying
24	our priest – lives forever – unchangeable priesthood
25	He continues to make intercession for us
26	holy, harmless, undefiled, separate from sinners, higher than the heavens
27	we do not need daily sacrifices
28	previously, men with weaknesses – now, the Son perfected forever

· The Priesthood & Tabernacle in Hebrews 8:1-5

Heb. 8:1-2	summary – our High Priest is at the right hand of the Father
3-5	shadow of heavenly things

· The Tabernacle in Hebrews 9

Heb. 9:1-2	the tabernacle
3-5	the second veil – the Holiest of all
6	first tabernacle
7	into the second veil – the high priest alone – once every year
8-10	a figure until the time of Christ
11	Christ became a High Priest – a greater and more perfect Tabernacle
23	pattern of things in the heavens
24	Christ did not enter the holy places made with hands – appeared in heaven
25-28	offered once
