- Proud Look

Prov. 21:24      proud & haughty man – “scoffer” is his name – he acts with arrogant pride

Gen. 3:1-5	the serpent – deceived Eve
Matt. 4:9	the devil – “fall down and worship me”
10	“you shall worship the Lord your God, and Him only shall you serve”
Luke 10:18	“I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven”
Jude 6	the angels who did not keep their proper domain, but left their own abode
Rev. 12:4	his tail drew 1/3 of the stars of heaven and threw them to the earth
7-9	war in heaven
Isaiah 10:12-15	God used the king of Assyria in prophecy – glory of his haughty looks
Isaiah 14:12	how are you fallen from heaven (O Lucifer, son of the morning) – how you are cut down to the ground, you who weakened the nations

13	for you have said in your heart – “I will ascend into heaven; I will exalt my throne above the stars of God; I will also sit on the mount of the congregation, on the farthest sides of the north”
14	“I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I will be like the Most High”
Ezek. 28:12-19	the Lord God – made comments about the king of Tyre
13	“You were in Eden (the garden of God)”
14	“You were the anointed cherub who covers” – on holy mountain of God
17	“Your heart was lifted up because of your beauty; you corrupted your wisdom for the sake of your splendor” – “I cast you to the ground”

· Humble Outlook – (loving yourself and loving other people)

Matt. 22:37-40	“you shall love your neighbor as yourself”
Matt. 7:12	treat people – as you want to be treated
Phil. 2:3	“in lowliness of mind, let each esteem others better than himself”
5-8	example of Christ – humbled Himself

· Bad examples

Matt. 20:25	many leaders – lord it over them – exercise authority over them
Matt. 23:6-15	many religious leaders – exalt themselves over people
2 Cor. 11:13-14	false apostles – Satan transforms himself into an angel of light
20	bondage – devour – steal – exalt – punch

· Good examples

Exod. 3:11	Moses was reluctant to speak – (also, Exodus 4:10-14)
Exod. 32:10-14	at that particular moment – Moses had a humble outlook
Acts 14:9-17	when the people of Lystra called Paul & Barnabas the names of 2 Roman gods, the two men reacted strongly against the idea
Romans 16:1-15	Paul thanked people – (29 people total – 10 were women)
Phil. 2:19-22	Paul complimented – Timothy
Rev. 19:10	an angel told John – “do not do that” – (do not fall down to worship me)
Rev. 22:8-9	an angel told John – “do not do that” – (do not fall down to worship me)

· Perfect example of the Son of God

Matt. 4:10	“you shall worship the Lord your God, and Him only shall you serve”
John 5:30	“I seek the will of the Father, who sent Me” – (also, John 6:38)
John 10:17-18	the Son – laid down His life – willingly
Matt. 26:36-44	garden of Gethsemane
1 Cor. 15:24-28	submission to the Father – that God may be all in all
