treat others as you would like to be treated

tenderness and boldness

2 Cor. 10:1-2

gentleness and boldness

1 Cor. 8:9

seek to not let your liberty become a stumbling block to other people

consider their weak conscience

1 Cor. 9:19-23

consider the individual needs and desires

- To the Jew, I became as a Jew
- To those under the law, I became as under the law
- To those who are without law, I became as one without law  
(Not being without law toward God)
- To the weak, I became weak

1 Cor. 10:23

all things are lawful for me, but not all things are helpful – all things are

lawful to me, but not all things edify

why is my liberty judged by another man’s conscience?

whatever you do – do all to the glory of God

give no offense – to the Jews, to the Greeks or to the Church of God

I seek to please people – not seeking my own profit – but the profit of  
many – that they might be saved
