- I began with an introductory scripture

Matt. 16:21            He began telling them – suffer, killed & raised

- Following are my 7 sections of scripture – chosen for March 28, 2026.

- Suffering – (First and Second sections of scripture)  
(I almost gave a presentation today: “Where Is God When It Hurts?”)
- 2 Cor. 1:3-10            Paul wrote  
3                        blessed be God  
                              Father of our Lord Jesus Christ  
                              the Father of mercies  
                              God of all comfort
- 4                        who comforts us  
8                        burdened beyond measure – above strength – despaired of life  
9                        not trust in ourselves – but trust in God  
10                        has delivered – does deliver – will deliver
- Matt. 26:36-44        the Son of God said  
37                        He began to be sorrowful and deeply distressed  
38                        “My soul is exceedingly sorrowful, even to death”  
39                        “If it is possible, let this cup pass from Me”  
42                        “If this cup cannot pass away from Me . . . , Your will be done”

· Suffering, leading to death – (Third, Fourth & Fifth sections of scripture)

Matt. 27:46, 51	suffering leading to death
46	Ninth hour – “My God, My God, why have you forsaken Me?”
51	the veil of the temple was torn in two from top to bottom
1 Cor. 5:7	purge out the old leaven, since you truly are unleavened – Christ is our Passover
1 Cor. 11:18-26	
23	on the night He was betrayed
23-24	broken bread – “do this in remembrance of Me”
25	after supper
18	must be differences among you
19	people can see the differences
20	you are not eating the Lord’s Supper
21	ahead of others – some are drunk
22	should you have this behavior among the brethren?
25	after supper – instruction about wine – “as often as you drink it” – “in remembrance of Me”

· Resurrection – Sixth and Seventh sections of scriptures

Acts 2:22-36	
22-24	you have crucified Him – God raised up – loosening the pains of death
25-28	quoting David
29	David is dead, buried and in his tomb – “to this day”
30	God had sworn an oath to raise up the Christ to sit on the throne
31-32	concerning the resurrection – this Jesus was raised
33	He is exalted to the right hand of God – and we have received the Holy Spirit
34-35	David did not ascent into the heavens – (no matter what he wrote in the book of Psalms)
36	let all the house of Israel know assuredly – that God has made this Jesus (whom you crucified) both Lord and Christ
Rom. 8:11	if the Spirit of Him (who raised Jesus from the dead) dwells in you, He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies – through His Spirit which dwells in you
