Exod. 12:15	eat unleavened bread – you shall remove leaven (food) from your house – whoever ate leavened food was cut off from Israel
18	you shall eat unleavened bread
19	for 7 days, no leaven (food) shall be in your house
Deut. 16:2	you shall sacrifice the Passover to the Lord – in the place where the Lord chooses to put His name – (sanctuary Passover – Tabernacle and Temple)
3	do not eat leavened bread – eat unleavened bread – that is, “the bread of affliction” (because you left the land of Egypt in haste)
4	no leaven (food) in your territory
5	“you may not sacrifice the Passover within any of your gates – but at the place where the Lord your God chooses to place His name” – (sanctuary Passover – Tabernacle and Temple)

Historical reminder – about the sanctuary Passover

| 2 Chron. 30:24 | King Hezekiah’s sanctuary Passover<br>Hezekiah – 1,000 bulls & 7,000 sheep<br>leaders – 1,000 bulls & 10,000 sheep |
| 2 Chron. 35:7  | King Josiah’s sanctuary Passover<br>30,000 lambs and goats<br>3,000 cattle   |
| 8              | leaders – 2,600 from the flock & 300 cattle  |
| 9              | leaders – 5,000 from the flock & 500 cattle  |
- Question – how many animals were sacrifice at the sanctuary Passover  
when the Son of God died?  
Please check what the historian Josephus reported.

Historical reminder – Two lessons about the leaven analogy

1. Leaving in haste  
Exod. 12:11 leaving in haste
  2. Putting sin out  
Rom. 6:1-2 since saved by grace – shall we continue to sin?  
1 Cor. 5:7 purge out the old leaven – since you are truly unleavened –  
Christ is our Passover  
John 10:28 no one can snatch you out of the Son's hand  
29 no one can snatch you out of the Father's hand

- Exod. 20:1-2 I brought you out of the land of Egypt (out of the house of bondage)  
3-17 the 10 Commandments
- Matt. 19:16 what shall we do to inherit eternal life?  
17 keep the commandments  
18-19 which ones? – just these 5?  
6 – you shall not murder  
7 – you shall not commit adultery  
8 – you shall not steal  
9 – you shall not bear false witness  
5 – honor your father and mother  
summary – love your neighbor as yourself
- Rom. 13:9-10 which ones? – just these 5?  
7 – you shall not commit adultery

summary – you shall love your neighbor as yourself
- Matt. 22:37 You shall love the Lord your God with heart, soul & mind  
39 You shall love your neighbor as yourself
- Matt. 19:20 “all these things I have kept from my youth – what do I still lack?”  
21 give to poor
- Mark 7:1-13 rituals – but not the Fifth commandment
- John 8:6 He wrote on the ground with His finger
